SCRAMBLE RULES

RULES:

- **1.** Regular Scramble Rules-One club length no nearer the hole. If in the rough, ball must remain in the rough. If in a hazard, ball must remain in the hazard.
- 2. Men play from White Tees. Women and Men 70 years or older play from Forward Tees. Men aged 65–69 play Combo Tees. Children 13 and under are allowed to play from the forward tees.
- **3.** String can be used to move ball closer to the hole or into the hole. This move does not cost you a stroke. Cut off the amount of string that was used. You cannot use the string to win a hole prize.
- 4. Two putt maximum. In other words, your second putt is automatically in.
- 5. Ties to be broken via scorecard rollback based on handicap holes.
- 6. Please turn in scorecard immediately following the round.
- 7. Please leave hole flags on course for a committee member to pickup.

You are here to have fun. Please enjoy the course and use it properly. Repair your ball marks, replace your divots, and please use the cart paths when provided. Stay 30 feet from the greens and obey the signs. In the event of severe weather, three sounds of the horn or siren means to mark your ball and head for shelter. Please join us in thanking Brian Tahtinen and Staff for their help with today's event.
